Dear MWF Leader:

MWF develops virtually all our policy positions based on Resolutions that are passed at our Annual Meeting. Throughout our history, resolutions have provided the MWF with policy and issue direction. This direction has been a fundamental springboard to our ability to advocate specific actions.

This year's Annual Meeting will be held in Helena between April 27 and April 29, 2012. Resolutions will be debated, amended, rejected and adopted at that time.

Any MWF member in good standing may submit a resolution. It is preferred, though not required, that the individual or a club submitting a resolution attend the Annual Meeting to discuss and articulate their submission, or have a representative attend to discuss the resolution.

I have enclosed a [Resolution Form/Format](#) for your use. Please read it over, discuss it with club members or other local MWF members, and participate in the process of establishing MWF policies.

The deadline for submission is February 24, 2012. Resolutions submitted late may only be considered through a process involving a special vote of Annual Meeting delegates.

Resolutions are intended to serve as policy declarations and not meant to designate specific actions.


